Moratorium - PCA, Respite and Supervised Independent Living Licenses

Monday, July 07, 2008

During the 2008 Regular Legislative Session, the Louisiana Legislature passed Act Number 328 (House Bill Number 1224) placing a Moratorium on the licensure of Personal Care Attendant (PCA), Supervised Independent Living (SIL) and Respite Care services. The Moratorium shall apply to any new applications received on or after July 1, 2008 and shall remain in effect until July 2010. The legislation does provide for exceptions in certain circumstances.
